Played on Gold Triple Sheet - On odd #'d days of the month dab all odd #'s. On even #'d days of the month dab all even #'s. Game: Full House. Accumulator adds 25% of sales per event if won in 18 called # s or less. Consolation is 50% of sales.

HOUSE RULES

NGCC BINGO HAS ADOPTED A "SCENT FREE" POLICY FOR OUR EVENTS. PLEASE REFRAIN FROM WEARING PERFUMES OR HEAVY SCENTS WHEN ATTENDING, AS SEVERAL PEOPLE HAVE ALLERGIC REACTIONS ©

- 1. Players are responsible to check booklets before start of play 10 pages per booklet.
- 2. A regular game book must be purchased to be eligible for any and all special games.
- 3. Paper sales for Early bird games stop after the first game has started. Paper sales for the Loonie sheet stop after Game #1 of the regular book has started.
- 4. Booklets or sheets must be marked by dabber. Verification numbers must be readable.
- 5. No one under age 16 years is allowed in the Bingo Hall. Proof of ID is required. 16- & 17-year-olds MUST be accompanied by an adult.
- It is the player's responsibility to call BINGO loud enough to stop play and <u>PLEASE RAISE YOUR HAND</u>. If the caller has started to call the next letter/number, he/she must continue.
- 7. In case of multiple winners, prize will be divided equally.
- Bonanza Board is provided as courtesy only. Verification of winning Bingo is determined by actual numbers drawn and displayed on bingo machines.
- 9. House reserves the right to refuse admission.
- 10. All Volunteers may play Bingo except for the Bingo Caller. If a situation arises and a player must leave the hall for a short time, the Bingo Chair will be able to play eards on a temporary basis.
- 11. House reserves the right to cancel due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather. Decision will be made by 4 pm and posted on the website.
- 12. No one under the age of 18 can purchase raffle or 50/50 tickets.
- 13. You can only win an accumulator pot OR consolation pot. You cannot collect both pots.
- 14. Bingo paper, sheets or booklets must not be cut or altered in any way.
- 15. If an accumulator prize is less than the consolation prize when a new pot has been started, the higher amount will be paid.

LOONIE POT

- 80% of accumulated sales until won. A purple strip will be provided to be played with games #1 & #2 of the regular game book.
- 2. Booklet(s) not eligible for the Loonie Pot will have the top corner of the book cut off.
- 3. First ball pulled out of bonanza machine (not including N's) will be the Loonie Ball for the evening.
- 4. **Loonie Pot can only be paid once per event.** You must bingo on the Loonie # and it must complete the game pattern.
- 5. Loonie Pot can be won on the book, Jackpot strip or Loonie Sheet. Accumulator games are not eligible.

ODD/EVEN GAME

- 1. On Odd numbered days of the month all ODD numbers are to be pre-dabbed.
- 2. On Even numbered days of the month all EVEN numbers are to be pre-dabbed.
- 3. Accumulator pot is won in 18 called #'s or less. Consolation is 50% of sales.
- 4. Accumulator pot adds 25% of sales per event.

- 1. Top Card Block of 6 Middle Card Block of 4 Bottom Card Block of 9
- 2. Payout is 60% of sales.

KNIGHTS ZIP LOONIE

- 1. Knights Zip Loonie number(s) are pre-called at Intermission. Game is 2 Lines Anyway. You must bingo on this number, and it must complete the game pattern.
